

RESOLUTION No. 2012-30

AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF AN APPLICATION TO THE TENNESSEE DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FOR THE SMALL CITIES BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM/CDBG FOR FISCAL YEAR 2012

WHEREAS, the governing body of Weakley County, Tennessee, having committed itself to the improvement of the community that it represents, wishes to make application for the acquisition of pumper trucks and equipment for both the Latham and Como-Ore Springs Volunteer Fire Departments; and

WHEREAS, having determined proper eligibility by CDBG program guidelines, said governing body wishes to make application for \$300,000 in grant funds to implement the aforementioned improvements and will commit local funds in the amount of \$24,800 to be provided by the Latham and Ore-Springs Fire Departments, to constitute a total project cost of \$324,800.




