The Public Safety Committee met on June 24, 2013 at 8:00 a.m. at the Weakley County Department of Finance in the conference room. Others present included Shawn Francisco-Director of Finance, Sheriff Mike Wilson, Keith Jones-Juvenile Service Officer, Jamison Peevyhouse-EMA Officer, and a representative from the Dresden Enterprise.

OLD BUSINESS

NEW BUSINESS:

Drug Control Fund Budget 2013-2014 FY

Sheriff Wilson presented the budget to the committee. He requested line #799 \$7,000 to be added to purchase monitor and recording equipment of undercover drug work. Commissioner Fortner made the motion to add line #799 \$7,000 to the 13-14 FY budget and with a second by Commissioner Wright the motion passed unanimously. Line #718 includes the purchase of two vehicles for 13-14 FY budget.

Jail Budget 13-14 FY

Sheriff Wilson requested 13 cameras at the cost of \$17,640 be added to the Jail budget for the 2013-14 FY. Discussion continued; however, the committee took no action. Sheriff Wilson requested the addition of \$6500 to line #336 for fiber optic installation at the Detention Center to prevent future lightning damage. Commissioner Wright made the motion to add \$6500 to line #336 and with a second by Commissioner McAlpin the motion passed unanimously.


