

RESOLUTION NO. 2014-13

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING BUDGET AMENDMENTS TO THE WEAKLEY COUNTY, TN GENERAL FUND FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2014.

WHEREAS, the State of Tennessee Office of Criminal Justice Programs has awarded the Weakley County Sheriff's Department a \$30,000 interlock assistance fund/improved DUI enforcement via area-wide saturation grant, with no local match; and

WHEREAS, the grant will provide the Weakley County Sheriff's Department funding for the purpose of obtaining and maintaining equipment in the enforcement of alcohol related traffic offenses; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds will be used to purchase sensitive minor equipment to include: in-car camera systems, radar units, vehicular lighting, DUI checkpoint systems, traffic cones, high visibility vests and flashlights.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the county legislative body of Weakley County, Tennessee assembled in regular session on this the 18th day of November 2013 in Dresden, Tennessee that:

SECTION 1. The Weakley County General Fund is hereby amended as follows:


