

RESOLUTION TO OPT OUT OF STATEWIDE BUILDING CODE STANDARDS FOR ONE-FAMILY AND TWO-FAMILY DWELLINGS IN WEAKLEY COUNTY, TN.

WHEREAS, Public Chapter 529 of the Public Acts of 2009, known as the "Tennessee Clean Energy Future Act of 2009", amends T.C.A. § 68-120-101 to apply statewide building code standards to one-family and two-family dwellings; and

WHEREAS, Public Chapter 529 authorizes counties and municipalities to opt out of these standards for one-family and two-family dwellings within the local government's jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Weakley County has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of the county for these standards not to apply to one-family and two-family dwellings within the county's jurisdiction. The Board of County Commission first opted out of these standards with Resolution No. 2011-31, passing in May 2011.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the Board of County Commissioners of Weakley County, meeting in regular session on this 17th day of November, 2014, that statewide building code standards, adopted pursuant to Title 68, chapter 120, shall not apply to one-family and two-family dwellings located within the jurisdictional boundaries of Weakley County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution shall take effect on the 17th day of November, 2014, the public welfare requiring it. This resolution shall be spread upon the minutes of the Board of County Commissioners

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the county clerk shall mail a certified copy of this resolution to the state fire marshal.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all resolutions of the Board of County Commissioners of Weakley County, Tennessee, which are in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed.


