RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION FOR A LITTER AND TRASH COLLECTING GRANT FROM THE TENNESSEE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF SAID GRANT TO THE WEAKLEY COUNTY, TENNESSEE, HIGHWAY FUND FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2016

SECTION 1.






