

RESOLUTION UPDATING WEAKLEY COUNTY WASTE TIRE PROGRAM

WHEREAS, Weakley County provides its residents with solid waste management services, convenience center for collection of solid waste, collective and disposal used tires, solid waste education, waste reduction and recycling programs; and

WHEREAS, State statutory law at Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 68-211-866(b), requires each county shall provide directly, by contract or through a solid waste authority at least one (1) site to receive and store waste tires for the use of the residents of the county; and

WHEREAS, presently the county waste tire site is used by residents and tire businesses, which imposes a large expenditure on the county, due to providing services to businesses; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated §68-211-835 (g)(1), allows for a reasonable fee to be charged by county, to cover cost of county handling tires above amount reimbursed by Tennessee Department of Revenue; and

WHEREAS, Weakley County wishes be to establish and maintain fiscally responsible waste tire collection program, as described in Tennessee Code Annotated, §68-211-866(b), by implementing a fee bearing a reasonable relationship to the cost of providing such services.

NOW THEREFOR, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Weakley County, Tennessee, meeting in regular session the 18th day of May, 2015, that a waste tire disposal fee program be established as follows:

1. The waste tire disposal fee (the fees) shall be collected on all tires, residents and commercial vendors, over four generated by a house hold per year and be based on tire weight and size. As follows:

TIRE TYPE	FEE PER TIRE	FEE PER TIRE IF STILL ON WHEEL
Passenger (up to 17" diameter)	\$ 2.00	\$ 5.00
Passenger or Light Truck (17" to 19" diameter)	\$ 3.00	\$ 6.00
Passenger or Truck (20" diameter and above)	\$ 5.00	\$ 10.00
Tractor (up to 26" diameter)	\$ 10.00	\$ 20.00
Tractor (28" and above diameter)	\$ 20.00	\$ 40.00
Skidder/Heavy Industrial Type	\$ 40.00	\$ 80.00


2. The collection point for waste tires is to be located at 608 County Maintenance Road, Dresden, Tennessee, and shall be the only established county sponsored site which will provide for residents of the county to dispose of tires, hereby establishing a program for residents, of Weakley County to cover the costs of waste tire management attributed to residents. The program to become effective 1 July, 2015.
3. The County may reimburse tire dealers fee paid to Department of Revenue (T.C.A. §67-4-1603) if number of tires to beneficial end-user is equal to or greater than amount paid into Department of Revenue upon county's receipt of certification of tires going to beneficial end-user.
4. The waste tire disposal fee (the fees) shall be due on delivery of tires to waste tire collection point with fees being collected as most advantages for county.
5. The solid waste disposal fees and collection procedures imposed by this resolution shall be effective July 1, 2015, the public welfare of Weakley County, Tennessee, requiring it.
6. The solid waste disposal fees and collections will be deposited in the Weakley County Solid Waste fund.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all resolutions of the Board of County Commissioners of Weakley County, Tennessee, which are in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution take effect from and after its passage, the public welfare requiring it. This resolution shall be spread upon the minutes of the, Board of County Commissioners.


