

**RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE WEAKLEY COUNTY, TN SICK LEAVE POLICY**

**WHEREAS**, the Tennessee Code Annotated Section 8-34-604, permits a political subdivision to allow their employees, upon retirement, who have any unused accumulated sick leave to be credited with such accrued leave as creditable service; and

**WHEREAS**, Weakley County’s sick leave policy for non-certified employees currently permits sick leave to be accumulated at a rate of one-half day for the first six months of employment and one day for each month thereafter accumulating to a maximum of ninety (90) days; upon retirement employees can submit to Tennessee Consolidated Retirement System any unused sick days to receive additional retirement credit.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Weakley County Legislative Body meeting in regular session at Dresden, Tennessee, on this 29th day of June, 2015, that: the Weakley County sick leave policy be amended removing the ninety (90) day maximum accumulation for non-certified employees.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that all resolutions of the Board of County Commissioners of Weakley County, Tennessee, which are in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed.
