December 8, 2014; 8:00 A.M.**

**Public Safety & Works Members Present:** Commissioners Tommy Jones, Earl Wright, David Hawks, James H. Westbrook, Jr., Eric Owen, James Roy Pope and James Bynum.

**Public Safety & Works Members Absent:** Commissioner Jack Vincent and Scott Fortner.

The Public Safety & Works Committee met on December 8, 2014 at 8:00 a.m. at the Weakley County Detention Center in the training room. Others present included Shawn Francisco - Director of Finance, Jake Bynum - County Mayor, Sheriff Mike Wilson, Charles Ross-Road Supervisor, Gary Mansfield-Road Board, Jamison Peevyhouse-911 Director, and Mike Stooksberry -CTAS.

Chairman Westbrook called the meeting.

Commissioner Wright made the motion to approve the November 13, 2014 Public Safety & Works Committee minutes and with a second by Commissioner Jones the motion passed unanimously.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

**Resolution #2015-22**

Supervisor Ross introduced the resolution presenting the 2014 Weakley County road list. Commissioner Owen made the motion to approve the resolution and with a second by Commissioner Hawks the motion passed unanimously.

**Update of Meth House Clean-Up**

Chairman Westbrook asked Sheriff Wilson to update the committee on the clean-up status. Sheriff Wilson stated the house and debris had been removed from the property and provided photos for the committee to review. Discussion followed. Commissioner Owen made the motion requesting the Director of Finance to dispose of the property via sealed bid process and with a second by Commissioner Bynum the motion passed unanimously.

**Waste Tires**

Mike Stooksberry addressed the committee regarding the state's waste tire procedures for vendors and the collection and disposal for county governments. He distributed a summary of the TN law pertaining to the waste tires. Mr. Stooksberry completed the cost data review for Weakley County's waste tire program and presented his results to the committee. He recommended that Weakley County tire dealers contract directly with a tire disposal company and the County discontinue this service to the tire dealers. Discussion continued and action was deferred until the next meeting.

**Solid Waste Collection Contract**

The committee has reviewed the current waste collection contract which expires in November 2015. Discussion continued. Commissioner Hawks made the motion to begin the sealed bid process for the solid waste collection services contract and with a second by Commissioner Pope the motion passed unanimously.

**Resolution #2015-23**



Chairman Westbrook made the motion to defer this resolution for further study and with a second by Commissioner Owen the motion passed unanimously.

County Mayor Bynum distributed information regarding the push for an increase in the state gas tax in the future and asked for the committee to study the data. No action was taken by the committee.


Having no further business, Commissioner Owen made the motion to adjourn and with a second by Commissioner Pope the meeting adjourned at 9:14 a.m.
