RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING BUDGET AMENDMENTS TO THE WEAKLEY COUNTY, TN GENERAL FUND FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2016.

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Health Department received Tobacco Settlement funds from the State of Tennessee, unspent funds are held in a reserve account; and

WHEREAS, the Tobacco Settlement program's purpose includes a "Baby and Me" campaign to teach and promote smoke free pregnancies and lifestyles; and

WHEREAS, these programs are in need of additional funds to continue advertising and supply expenditures.

SECTION 1. The Weakley County General Fund is hereby amended as follows:






