

RESOLUTION NO. 1989-32

TO APPROVE ASBESTOS ABATEMENT LOAN
FOR THE WEAKLEY COUNTY SCHOOL SYSTEM

WHEREAS, subject to the approval of the Board of County Commissioners of Weakley County, Tennessee, the Weakley County Board of Education has adopted a resolution to enter into a loan agreement with the United States Environmental Protection Agency for funds to undertake an asbestos abatement project; and

WHEREAS, this is an interest-free 20 year loan in the amount of \$42,000. The loan will be repaid in annual installments of \$2,100 each beginning in 1991. The proceeds of this loan, together with the proceeds of a matching grant from the United States Environmental Protection Agency, will be used to remove asbestos from Greenfield High School and Martin Junior High; and


WHEREAS, it appears advantageous to Weakley County to enter into said loan agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Weakley County, Tennessee, in regular session on this the 17th day of July, 1989, that:

Section 1. The Superintendent of Schools and the County Finance Director are hereby authorized to execute on behalf of the Weakley County Board of Education the loan agreement and promissory note and other documents or instruments relating to said agreement or note.


Section 2. The loan agreement and promissory note shall be in substantially the following form: (See Exhibits A & B).
