

WEAKLEY COUNTY LEGISLATIVE BODY
REGULAR MEETING APRIL 15, 1991

The board of county commissioners met in regular session on April 15, 1991 with Co. Executive Kerry Killebrew calling the meeting to order and Comm. Charles Culver had invocation. The entire court said the pledge of allegiance and Sheriff Mike Wilson opened court. County Clerk Faye Butts called roll with 19 present and 1 absent, that being Comm. David McAlpin, who is in the Persian Gulf.

Approval of Corrected minutes of regular meeting and on January 21, 1991 and special session on April 1, 1991 was made by Comm. John Bucy and seconded by Comm. Ronnie Bates. After a voice vote, motion carried.

TRUSTEE REPORT: Motion to accept the trustee report was made by Comm. V. J. Shanklin and seconded by Comm. Sam Sinclair. After a voice vote, motion carried.

GENERAL FUND REPORT: Motion to accept the General Fund Report was made by Comm. James Harold Bell, and seconded by Comm. Lewis Garner. After a voice vote, motion carried.

HIGHWAY DEPT. REPORT: Motion to accept the Highway Dept report was made by Comm. Earl Wright and seconded by Comm. George Broussard. After a voice vote, motion carried.

SCHOOL DEPT. REPORT: Motion to accept the report was made by Comm. V. J. Shanklin and seconded by Comm. Jimmy Brasfield. After a voice vote, motion carried.

NURSING HOME REPORT: Co. Exec. Kerry Killebrew ask the Nursing Home Committee to look into Com. Sinclair's comments of expanding the nursing home and report back to the court in July. A report was handed out and motion to accept this report was made by Comm. Harris and seconded by Comm. J. T. Walker. After a voice vote, motion carried.

CHAMBER OF COMMERCE REPORT: Suezane Speight gave a very enlightening and informative report of the Weakley County Industry Retention and Expansion Study, reporting a positive ecomic outlook. A booklet was handed to each commissioner. Motion to accept this report was made by Comm. George Broussard and seconded by Comm. Vernon Dunn. After a voice vote, motion carried.

BUDGET COMMITTEE REPORT: No report.

HEW REPROT: Comm. Vincent reported that the committee unanimously supported Resolution # 33, Private Commercial Landfills. Also, in the process of transferring the Rural Santation Service to the new owner and it is going well. The mapping and addressing has started well. Motion to accept this report was made by Comm. VanCleave and seconded by Comm. J. T. Walker. After a voice vote, motion carried.

FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT: Comm. Vernon Dunn reported all is going well and they are working on next years budget. Motion to accept this report was made by Comm. V. J. Shanklin and seconded by Comm. Joe Brasher. After a voice vote, motion carried.

LAW ENFORCEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT: Comm. VanCleave reported on the budget transfers and they did discuss the audit and everyone knows how the travel vouchers are to be filled out.
