

WEAKLEY COUNTY LEGISLATIVE BODY
REGULAR MEETING APRIL 18, 1994

The regular meeting of the county commission met on April 18, 1994 with Co. Exec. Kerry Killebrew calling the meeting to order. Invocation was given by Comm. Earl Wright and the Pledge of Allegiance was given by all. Sheriff Mike Wilson opened court and County Clerk, Faye Butts, called roll with 17 present, 2 absent. The court consist of 19 members since the passing of Comm. James H. Bell.

A resolution honoring Comm. James H. Bell, deceased, was read by Co. Exec. Kerry Killebrew to the entire court. After each commissioner signed the resolution, it was mailed to Mrs. James H. Bell. Resolution on page 369 of the minutes.

Approval of regular meeting of the County Commission on January 17, 1994. The motion was made by Comm. Vernon Dunn and seconded by Comm. John Bucy. After a voice vote, motion carried.

Motion to accept the TRUSTEE REPORT, GENERAL FUND, HIGHWAY DEPT. AND SCHOOL REPORT was made by Comm. Johnny Oliver and seconded by Comm. Gene Harris. After a voice vote, motion carried.

AMBULANCE COMMITTEE REPORT: Comm. Earl Wright, chairman, reported that all is well, with no complaints

BUDGET REPROT:Comm. Charles Culver, chairman, said budget transfers are to be presented later on the agenda.

FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT: Comm. Vernon Dunn, chairman, said the committe had met and all was going well. Ann Bynum had been replaced and there were no complaints.

LAW ENFORCEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT: Comm. VanCleave, chairman, reported they made budget transfer and made mention of the possibility for funds on state prisoners maybe cut by the next budget, it may run in the red. It will need to be looked into later.

Motion to accept all the above reports was made by Comm. Wayne McCreight and seconded by Comm. John Bucy. After a voice vote, motion carried.

HEW REPORT: Comm. Vincent, chairman, announced that a Memorial Day service will be held at 11:00 am on May 30, at the War Memorial Monument on the courthouse lawn in Dresden. Also, Comm. Vincent reported that approximately 200 inuries were reported during the past 12 months. He state that the HEW Committee would like to get regular reports from the newly formed Safety Committee, and would like the Committee to give recommendations for lowering accidents, in an attempt to reduce insurance premiums. He also requested that the Commission do whatever is necessary to get the E911 on the ballot in August. Motion to accept this report was made by Comm. Earl Wright and seconded by Comm. Ronnie Bates. After a voice vote, motion carried.

Comm. Brasher request a report on the salaries of Weakley County principals, supervisors, and the sperintendent. Comm. Salmon, chairman, stated that they voted for it to go back to the state schedule and let the School Board determine who will work the extra months. Motion to accept this report was made by Comm. McAlpin and seconded by Comm. Vernon Dunn. After a voice vote, motion carried.

Comm. VanCleave nominates Mac Buckley to fill the vacant seat of Comm. James Harold Bell. Comm. Brasfield seconded the motion. After a roll call vote, motion carried.

Co. Exec. Killebrew also appointed Comm. Buckley to the Property Committee, Road Committee and the Beer Board. He also appointed Comm. Phebus to the Building and Budget Committees.

Co. Exec. Kerry Killebrew appointed a new Re-districting Committee to look into correcting the population discrepancies between the various Commission Districts in Weakley County. The committee is composed of Commissioners Charles Culver, Vernon Dunn, J. T. Walker Dick Phebus and Joe Brasher.

Motion to ratify the Private Act providing for a Newly-Constituted Board of Education was made by Comm. J. T. Walker and seconded by Comm. Johnny Vincent. After a roll call vote, motion carried.
