

REGULAR MEETING OF COMMISSIONERS  
OCTOBER 21, 1991

The regular meeting of the Weakley County Commissioners met on October 21, 1991 with Co. Exec. Kerry Killebrew calling the meeting to order and Comm. Earl Wright had invocation. Sheriff Mike Wilson opened the court and County Clerk Faye Butts called roll with 19 present and one not present, that being Comm. Sam Sinclair who resigned as of October 14, 1991. Mr. Sinclair moved out of his district. Approval of minutes of July 15, 1991 was made by Comm. James H. Bell and seconded by Comm. Vernon Dunn.

TRUSTEE'S REPORT: Motion to accept the trustee report was made by Comm. Lewis Garner and seconded by Comm. John Salmon. After a voice vote, motion carried.

GENERAL FUND REPORT: Motion to accept the general fund report was made by Comm. James H. Bell and seconded by Comm. Jerry Carpenter. After a voice vote, motion carried.

HIGHWAY DEPT. REPORT: Motion to accept this report was made by Comm. George Broussard and seconded by Comm. Charles Culver. After a voice vote, motion carried.

SCHOOL DEPT. REPORT: Motion to accept this report was made by Comm. John Bucy and seconded by Comm. Vernon Dunn. After a voice vote, motion carried.

AMBULANCE COMMITTEE REPORT: Comm. Earl Wright, chairman, reported there were no problems with the ambulance service. Motion to accept this report was made by Comm. Johnny Vincent and seconded by Comm. Jimmy Brasfield. After a voice vote, motion carried.

HEW REPROT: The Veterans Day Program will be November 11, 1991 at the Dresden High School and everyone has been extended an invitation to this program. We are in the process of applying for a communciation grant that will update our communication system for all emergency services. This will work real closely with out 911 system when complete. Motion to accept this report was made by Comm. J. T. Walker and seconded by Comm. John Bucy. After a voice vote, motion carried.

NURSING HOME REPORT: Comm. Wayne McCreight ask David McBride the reason for the \$8,000.00 loss and it was because no insurance claims were paid in the months of May, June, July since they were in a transistion period by changing insurance carriers. Comm. McCreight ask Mr. McBride if it would be possible to provide the commission with the latest financial statement or audit as they become current. Mr. McBride will comply with this request. Motion to accept this motion was made by Comm. Earl Wright and seconded by Comm. James H. Bell. After a voice vote, motion carried.

LAW ENFORCEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT: Comm. VanCleave, chairman, reported that the committee voted unanimously to fund the constables bonds. After much discussion about the county liability, and needing the amount of warrants the constables serve, Comm. VanCleave recommended that the budget committee put this on their agenda and consider it and then be brought before the county commission at the next meeting after it's done. Co. Exec. Killebrew ask that all the information be presented at the next meeting. Motion to accept this report was made by Comm. Joe Brasher and seconded by Comm. Earl Wright. After a voice vote, motion carried.

AGRCULTURAL EXTENSION SERVICE REPORT: Motion to accept this report was made by Comm. Wayne McCreight and seconded by Comm. George Broussard. After a voice vote, motion carried.

WCMES REPORT: Gerald Brooks reproted to the court that he was going to retire as of November 1, 1991 and that Junior Moore would be taking his place. He also turned in his report. Motion to accept this report was made by Comm. James H. Bell and seconded by Comm. Gene Harris. After a voice vote, motion carried.

ELECTION OF CHAIRMAN OF COMMISSION: Comm. V. J. Shanklin nominates Co. Exec. Kerry Killebrew and to be elected by accalimation. Seconded by Comm. Jerry Carpenter. After a voice vote, motion carried.

ELECTION OF CHAIRMAN PROTEMPORE: Comm. Wayne McCreight nominates Comm. Johnny Vincent and Comm. Lewis Garner seconded the motion. Comm. Jerry Carpenter makes the motion that Comm. Vincent be elected by accalimation and Comm. Vernon Dunn seconded the motion. After a voice vote, motion carried.
