PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE
November 13, 2006; 4:30 P.M.**

OLD BUSINESS:

Commissioner Wright made the motion to approve the September 11, 2006 minutes and with a second by Commissioner Salmon the motion passed, with Commissioner Stewart opposing.

NEW BUSINESS:

Resolution #2007-20

The resolution was previously approved by the FWM committee. The resolution appropriates fund for the receipt of a Sheriff's Department grant in the amount of \$5000 and additional grant money for Emergency Management. Commissioner Wright made the motion to approve the resolution and with a second by Commissioner Salmon the motion passed unanimously.

Emergency Management Issues

Mark Seat explained to the committee that City of Martin was going to charge \$250 per month to the County for the safe keeping of emergency management supplies and equipment. Mark stated that this would not be suitable & requested if anyone had any knowledge of a location where these supplies & equipment could be stored. Discussion continued.

Commissioner Stewart made the motion to adjourn and with a second by Commissioner Salmon the meeting adjourned at 4:39 p.m.
