The Public Safety Committee met on Wednesday, May 12, 2004, 4:00 p.m., at the Weakley County Department of Finance in the conference room in Dresden for the purpose of discussing the budget transfers. Chairman Vincent called the meeting to order.

OLD BUSINESS:

Chairman Vincent asked for a recap of the Safety Committee meeting. Mrs. Francisco updated the committee stating that work compensation issues were discussed as well as the county becoming a certified drug-free county.

NEW BUSINESS:

Commissioner Wright made the motion to approve the March 8, 2004 minutes. Commissioner McAlpin seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

Emergency Management Budget Transfer

This transfer was previously approved by the Finance, Ways, & Means Committee. Various line items are in need of realignment. Commissioner McAlpin made the motion to approve the budget transfer and with a second by Commissioner Hunt the motion passed unanimously.

General Sessions Budget Transfer

This transfer was previously approved by the Finance, Ways, & Means Committee. The budget transfer is necessary into the travel line item due to the judge's increased travel regarding the municipal court issues. Commissioner Wright made the motion to approve the budget transfer and with a second by Commissioner Hunt the motion passed unanimously.

Sheriff Department Budget Transfer

This transfer was previously approved by the Finance, Ways, & Means Committee. Various line items are in need of realignment. Commissioner Salmon made the motion to approve the budget transfer and with a second by Commissioner Hunt the motion passed unanimously.

Jail Department Budget Transfer

This transfer was previously approved by the Finance, Ways, & Means Committee. Realignment of line items in the jail budget are necessary. Commissioner Hunt made the motion to approve the budget transfer and with a second by Commissioner Salmon the motion passed unanimously.

Resolution #2004-31

This transfer was previously approved by the Finance, Ways, & Means Committee. The Chancery Court reserve funds need to be placed in the 2003-04 FY budget to purchase new computer workstations for the Clerk & Master's office. Commissioner McAlpin made the motion to approve the budget transfer and with a second by Commissioner Wright the motion passed unanimously.

Resolution # 2004-32

Commissioner Hunt made the motion to approve the resolution and with a second by Commissioner Salmon the motion passed unanimously.
