

RESOLUTION NO. 1996-21

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING BUDGET AMENDMENTS TO THE WEAKLEY COUNTY, TENNESSEE, HIGHWAY FUND FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1996.

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Highway Department has received a grant not to exceed \$10,500 from the State of Tennessee, Department of Environmental and Conservation; and

WHEREAS, this grant is for the provision of providing assistance to establish used oil collection centers, developing used oil educational programs and purchasing equipment that burns used oil fuel.
