

RESOLUTION NO. 1998 - 28

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A LIBRARY BUILDING FOR WEAKLEY COUNTY

WHEREAS, the present library building is grossly inadequate due to lack of space, handicapped accessibility and parking, and;

WHEREAS, the present library is not owned by the County but has been in rented space for many years, and;

WHEREAS, Governor Ned McWherter has donated land valued at \$60,156 and approximately \$300,000 in stock to finance the construction, furnishing and equipping of a library building in and for Weakley County, and;

WHEREAS, Weakley County has received \$100,000 from the State of Tennessee to be applied to the construction of a library building, and;

WHEREAS, funds in the amount of \$405,000 have previously been appropriated to erect, furnish and equip a building to be used as a library in and for Weakley County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the county legislative body of Weakley County, Tennessee assembled in regular session on this the 17th day of November 1997 in Dresden, Tennessee, that:


SECTION 1. The County Executive is authorized to accept the property donated by Governor Ned McWherter and to enter into an agreement with David Todd Construction Company to purchase a building located at 341 Linden Street in Dresden, Tennessee, to be used as a library building in and for Weakley County, Tennessee.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all resolutions of the Board of County Commissioners of Weakley County, Tennessee, which are in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution take effect from and after its passage, the public welfare requiring it. This resolution shall be spread upon the minutes of the Weakley County Board of County Commissioners.


