

RESOLUTION NO. 1999-15

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING BUDGET AMENDMENTS
TO THE WEAKLEY COUNTY, TN GENERAL FUND
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1999.

WHEREAS, the Veterans Service Officer Search Committee has recommended that the Veteran's Service Office be staffed by a part-time (three days per week) Veterans Service officer and a full-time secretary, effective October 1, 1998; and

WHEREAS, the Search Committee has recommended that this office be dedicated solely for the purpose of assisting veterans and be separated from the Emergency Management function; and

WHEREAS, the general public and the County Commission is requiring more accountability in County offices; and

WHEREAS, this will require amendments to the 1998-99 County General Fund Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the county legislative body of Weakley County, Tennessee assembled in regular session on this the 21st day of September, 1998 in Dresden, Tennessee that:

SECTION 1. The Weakley County General Fund is hereby amended as follows:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the director of Emergency Management or his designee, shall continue to issue Building Permits, as provided be Chapter 205 Private Acts of 1992, from this office for the next six months or until such time as said Private Act is amended to transfer the responsibility to another office.

SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all resolutions of the Board of County Commission of Weakley County, Tennessee, which are in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution take effect from and after its passage, the public welfare requiring it. This resolution shall be spread upon the minutes of the Board of County Commissioners.
