

**RESOLUTION NO. 1999-19**

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING BUDGET AMENDMENTS  
TO THE WEAKLEY COUNTY, TN GENERAL FUND  
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1999.**

**WHEREAS**, Weakley County has received a Local Law Enforcement Block Grant (LLEBG) in the amount of \$10,384.00; and

**WHEREAS**, this LLEBG program is a formal program based on a jurisdictions number of Uniform Crime Report Part I violent crimes reported to the Federal Bureau of Investigation; and

**WHEREAS**, Weakley County will match the LLEBG received by 10% in the amount of \$1,154.00.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the county legislative body of Weakley County, Tennessee assembled in regular session on this the 21st day of September, 1998 in Dresden, Tennessee that:

**SECTION 1.** The Weakley County, General Fund is hereby amended as follows:



