

Resolution Authorizing Budget Amendments
 To The General Purpose School Fund
 For The Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2000

WHEREAS, Technology Literacy Grant revenues have been received from the state to be dispensed to teachers that chose to participate;
 WHEREAS, TLG expenditures are to be dispensed to teachers that participated in training on use of e-mail to access lessons and lesson plans;
 WHEREAS, teacher trainees are to receive \$250, less benefits;
 WHEREAS, two out of county trainers were used by some teachers and were to be paid an amount set by state and paid by state (\$6,560).

 that:


SECTION 1. The General Purpose School Fund is hereby amended as follows:




