RESOLUTION PLACING THE ~~ADMINISTRATION~~^{OVERSIGHT} OF
COUNTY CONSOLIDATED SERVICE STATION UNDER
THE FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, it appears that the County Consolidated Service Station has been operating at a deficit for number of years; and

WHEREAS, it appears that the markup required for gasoline, diesel and oil to make the consolidation service station self-supporting makes the price for these items higher than can for purchased at the retail level; and

WHEREAS, the increase in fuel prices at the consolidated service station has had and continues to have a negative impact on the highway, school and sheriff's departments; and

WHEREAS, a serious study should be made of the future of the consolidated service station; and


WHEREAS, the proper entity to oversee this county department appears to be the Financial Management Committee, which includes the County Executive, Highway Supervisor, Superintendent of Schools and four county commissioners; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the county legislative body of Weakley County, Tennessee assembled in regular session on this the 18th day of January 2000 in Dresden, Tennessee that the oversight of the Weakley County Consolidated Service Station be a function of the Financial Management Committee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all resolutions of the Board of County Commissioners of Weakley County, Tennessee, which are in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution take effect from and after its passage, the public welfare requiring it. This resolution shall be spread upon the minutes of the Board of County Commissioners.


