

RESOLUTION NO. 2002-22

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING BUDGET AMENDMENTS
TO THE WEAKLEY COUNTY, TN GENERAL FUND
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2002.

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Circuit Court Judge has requested that the jurors serving on some of the jury trials in the Weakley County Courthouse remain inside the Courthouse during the meal time hours; and

WHEREAS, due to the Circuit Court Judge's request the Circuit Court Clerk is responsible for providing meals for these jurors; and

WHEREAS, no line item was established in the Circuit Court 01-02 FY budget to pay this expenditure; and

WHEREAS, funds in the amount of \$1,500 are available for transfer in the Jury & Witness Fee line item; therefore the 01-02FY budget must be amended \$1,500.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the county legislative body of Weakley County, Tennessee assembled in regular session on this the 19th day of November 2001 in Dresden, Tennessee that:

SECTION 1. The Weakley County General Fund is hereby amended as follows:
