

RESOLUTION NO. 2002-61

RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE WEAKLEY COUNTY, TENNESSEE SICK LEAVE POLICY.

WHEREAS, the Tennessee Code Annotated Section 8-34-604(c), permits a political subdivision to allow their employees, upon retirement, who have any unused accumulated sick leave to be credited with such accrued leave as creditable service; and

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Personnel Committee has unanimously approved the removal of the maximum ninety (90) days allowance for the accumulation of sick leave; and

WHEREAS, the Weakley County sick leave policy is that sick leave will accumulate at a rate of one-half day for the first six months of employment and one day for each month thereafter accumulating infinitely; and

WHEREAS, all liabilities resulting from this Resolution shall be the responsibility of the political subdivision and not the State of Tennessee.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the county legislative body of Weakley County, Tennessee assembled in regular session on this the 24th of June 2002 in Dresden, Tennessee that the Weakley County, Tennessee sick leave policy is amended removing the ninety (90) day maximum accumulation; thus allowing full-time employees to accumulate sick leave infinitely.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all resolutions of the Board of County Commissioners of Weakley County, Tennessee, which are in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution take effect from and after its passage, the public welfare requiring it. This resolution shall be spread upon the minutes of the Board of County Commissioners.
