

RESOLUTION BY WEAKLEY COUNTY COMMISSION ENDORSING
CONSTRUCTION OF VETERANS MEMORIAL ON THE COURTHOUSE GROUNDS

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Commission feels that it is time to honor the men and women from Weakley County who made the ultimate sacrifice for all of us, as well as those who did service in the conflicts beginning with WWI, and

WHEREAS, the Commission believes the proper way to show our thanks and appreciation to those who lost their lives in time of war would be the construction of a memorial monument on the southeast corner of the courthouse lawn, and

WHEREAS, the Commission requests the Budget Committee to insert One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500) as the initial ten percent of the cost with the remainder to be raised from private and corporate donations, and

WHEREAS, the Commission strongly urges all citizens of Weakley County to become involved with this wonderful project to honor those who served so that we might enjoy the freedom we have as Americans.
