New Business

Sharon Senior Center Budget Transfer

The transfer has previously been approved by this committee. An amended transfer was distributed to the members. The transfer requests funds to be moved from the medical insurance line item to the salary and corresponding benefit line items. Commissioner Owen made the motion to approve the budget transfer and with a second by Commissioner Phebus the motion passed unanimously.

Old Jail Building

Chairman Westbrook updated the committee on a quote he had received from County Mayor Patrick on the demolition of the building. Trenton Recycling, the company that is currently doing work at the fire damage Chamber of Commerce site, stated that the demolition of the building would cost \$24,800; this price includes the removal of the asbestos materials. Commissioner Owen made the motion for the Director of Finance to take bids for the demolition and disposal of the old jail building. Commissioner Phebus seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Commissioner Phebus made the motion to adjourn and with a second by Commissioner Owen the meeting adjourned at 4:59 p.m.
