OLD BUSINESS:

Commissioner Salmon made the motion to approve the November 14, 2011 minutes with a second by Commissioner McAlpin the motion passed unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS:

TRANSFER # 1112-06

This transfer is at the request of the Circuit Court Clerk to transfer funds. Commissioner Wright made the motion to approve the transfer and with a second by Commissioner McAlpin the motion passed unanimously.

RESOLUTION #2012-24

The resolution is accepting the safety grant in the amount of \$5,000, with no local contribution. The resolution Commissioner Wright made the motion to approve the resolution and with a second by Commissioner Bell the resolution was unanimously approved.

RESOLUTION #2012-28

The resolution is at the request of EMA accepting a HAZMAT 80/20 split training grant. The 20% will be local funded with in-kind contribution. Commissioner Salmon made the motion to approve the resolution and with a second by Commissioner Bell the resolution was unanimously approved.

Other Business

Bob Dudley and Lynn Scarbrough spoke to the committee regarding the moving of the City of Greenfield and Pillowville Volunteer Fire Departments fire response line in Weakley County. Eight-eight (88) households will be transferred from the City of Greenfield to Pillowville volunteer fire station. The committee did not object to this transfer.
