## **WEAKLEY COUNTY LEGISLATIVE BODY MEETING**

**SEPTEMBER 16, 2013**

The Weakley County Legislative Body met in Regular Session on September 16, 2013 in the County Commission Room. Chairman Westbrook called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Judge Moore gave the invocation.

All members present gave the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

County Clerk, Pat Scarbrough, called the Roll with 17 members present and one member, Commissioner Rich, was absent.

Chairman Westbrook called for a Motion to approve the Minutes from the July 29, 2013 Meeting. Commissioner Sinclair made a Motion and Commissioner Jones placed a second. There were not any additions, deletions or corrections and a voice vote was taken, the ayes have it with none opposed. The Minutes from the July 29, 2013 Meeting were approved.

### **COMMUNICATION TO COMMISSION:**

The Financial Reports were included in the packets. Commissioner Vincent made a Motion to accept the reports as filed and Commissioner Wright placed a second. A voice vote was taken and the ayes have it. The reports were accepted as filed.

### **MESSAGE FROM COUNTY MAYOR:**

Next was the Veterans Service Officer Report that was included in the packet. Commissioner McAlpin made a motion and a second was placed by Commissioner Taylor to accept as filed. A voice vote was taken and the Veterans Report was accepted as filed.

Next was the Comptroller of Treasury Form CT-0253 General Fund and the Comptroller of Treasury Letter dated August 27, 2013. This form and Letter were included in the packets. Commissioner Stewart made a Motion to file these with the County Clerk and to be made a part of the Minutes. Commissioner Farmer placed a second and a voice vote was taken and the ayes have it with none opposed.

**ELECTIONS, APPOINTMENTS AND CONFIRMATIONS:**

First was the election of Chairman. Chairman Pro Tempore Wright took the floor and gave the Committee on Committees report. It was unanimous to nominate Commissioner Westbrook. Motion was made by Commissioner Jones to approve by acclamation. A voice vote was taken and the ayes have it with none opposed. Commissioner Westbrook was elected Chairman of the Weakley County Legislative Body.

Chairman Westbrook called for the Committee on Committee Report for Chairman Pro Tempore. Commissioner Wright commented that it was unanimous to nominate Commissioner Stewart as Chairman Pro Tempore. A voice vote was taken and the ayes have it Commissioner Stewart was elected Chairman Pro Tempore.

Next were the appointments of Weakley County Board of Commissioners Committee Members. Commissioner Wright gave the Committee on Committees Report; he commented that there had not been any changes to the Committees. Commissioner Wright made the Motion and Commissioner Stewart placed a second. A voice vote was taken and the ayes have it with none opposed. The Committees were approved.

The appointment of County Safety Officer was next. Jamison Peevyhouse was nominated and a voice vote was taken with none opposed. The appointment of Jamison Peevyhouse as County Safety Officer was approved.

Next was the appointment of County Service Officer and Ronald Cheatham was nominated. A voice vote was taken with none opposed. Ronald Cheatham was appointed as County Service Officer.

Next was the Election of Notaries Public. Commissioner Fortner made a motion and Commissioner Taylor placed a second. A voice vote was taken and the ayes have it with none opposed. The List of Notaries Public was approved.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

**RESOLUTION NO. 2014-05:** Resolution To Affirm and Support “It Can Wait” National Day of Action and The National Non-Texting-While-Driving Movement. Sponsored by Commissioners Salmon and Wright.

Commissioner Salmon made a motion and a second placed by Commissioner Fortner. Discussion and the question were called. A voice vote was taken and the ayes have it with none opposed. The Motion carried.

**RESOLUTION NO. 2014-06:** Resolution To Establish an Updated Occupational Safety and Health Program Plan, Devise Rules and Regulations, and to Provide For a Safety Director and The Implementation of Such Plan. Sponsored by Commissioners Salmon and Wright.

The Committee report was given by Commissioner Vincent from Public Safety it passed unanimously and it also passed unanimously in Health Education and Economic Development Committee. Commissioner Jones made a motion and Commissioner Vincent placed a second. A voice vote was taken and the ayes have it with none opposed. The Motion carried.

**RESOLUTION 2014-07:** Resolution To Authorize the Weakley County Clerk To collect A Motor Vehicle Regulatory Fee Imposed By The City of Gleason. Sponsored by Commissioners Owen and Salmon.

The Committee Report from Finance Ways and Means passed unanimously. Commissioner Owen made a motion and Commissioner Stewart placed a second. Discussion and question was called. A voice vote was taken and the ayes have it with none opposed. Motion carried.

**RESOLUTION NO. 2014-08:** Resolution Authorizing The Increase of the Weakley County Drivers Safety School Fee and Budget Amendments to the General Fund For The Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2014. Sponsored by Commissioners McAlpin and Salmon.

This Resolution passed the Public Safety Committee unanimously and Finance Ways and Means unanimously. Discussion was called and Commissioner Medling questioned why this was being done. Sheriff Wilson commented that the County has been charging \$50.00 per person and the County is increasing to \$75.00 per person. This is what surrounding Counties are charging. Question was called and a voice vote was taken with 16 ayes and Commissioner Medling placed a nay. Motion carried.

**RESOLUTION NO. 2014-09:** Authorizing The Submittal of an Application To The Tennessee Department of Economic and Community Development for the Community Development Block Program for Imminent Threat. Sponsored by Commissioners Jones and Salmon.

This passed Public Safety Committee unanimously and Finance Ways and Means unanimously. Commissioner Jones made a motion and Commissioner Wright placed a second. Discussion was called and the question a voice vote was taken and the ayes carried with none opposed. The Motion carried.

**RESOLUTION NO. 2014-10:** Resolution Authorizing Budget Amendments To The General Fund For The Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2014. Sponsored by Commissioners Hawks and Vincent.

This Resolution passed Health Education and Economic Development and the Finance Ways and Means Committees unanimously. Commissioner Hawks made a motion and Commissioner Fortner placed a second. Discussion was called and the question. County Clerk, Pat Scarbrough, called the Roll with 17 ayes and one absent. The Motion carried.
