

RESOLUTION No. 2014-09

AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF AN APPLICATION TO THE TENNESSEE DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FOR THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK PROGRAM FOR IMMINENT THREAT

WHEREAS, the governing body of Weakley County, Tennessee, having committed itself to the improvement of the community that it represents, wishes to make application for the replacement of a pumper tanker, SCBA, and personal protective equipment; and,

WHEREAS, having determined proper eligibility by CDBG program guidelines, said governing body wishes to make application for \$111,400 in grant funds to implement the aforementioned improvements and will commit local funds in the amount of \$120,000 to be provided by the Sidonia Volunteer Fire Department, to constitute a total project cost of \$231,400.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body of Weakley County, Tennessee, meeting in session on this the 16th day of September, 2013 that the Mayor of Weakley County is authorized to sign an application for CDBG funds, to commit local matching funds to the proposed project, and to sign and all necessary assurances, agreements or contracts required for recipients of CDBG funds.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all resolutions of the Board of County Commissioners of Weakley County, Tennessee, which are in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution take effect from and after its passage, the public welfare requiring it. This resolution shall be spread upon the minutes of the, Board of County Commissioners.
