

RESOLUTION.

WHEREAS, This court, at the October 1942 session, adopted a resolution designating the firms of W.N. Estes and Company, J.C. Bradford and Company and Nashville Securities Company all of Nashville, Tennessee, as the County's exclusive agents for the purpose of undertaking to obtain all or as many as possible of the outstanding bonds of the issue of \$644,000 Highway Bonds of Weakley County, dated May 1, 1927 and maturing May 1, 1947, all for the purpose of exchanging the same into State of Tennessee Consolidated Bonds for County Reimbursement and thereby retiring the same as a debt of Weakley County; and

WHEREAS, all of these bonds, with the exception of \$63,000.00 have now been acquired and cancelled; and

WHEREAS, the County's agents desire an extension of their engagement for a period extending to October 2, 1944, under the same terms as heretofore granted in the resolution approved by this Court at the October 1942 session.

Esquire C.C. Underwood moved the adoption of the within resolution seconded by Esquire J. Martin Adams, and upon roll call same was adopted.
