
Whereas, it appears to the Weakley County Quarterly Court this day assembled in regular session at the Court House, in Dresden, Tennessee, there being present and presiding the Honorable Cayce Pentecost, County Judge, Shobe Smith, Jr. County Court Clerk, and Jess Davis Sheriff, and a quorum of the members of the Weakley County Quarterly Court being present, that the Dresden High School is now and has been for many years admitting to school and providing all such means and facilities at hand for the full completion of the regular high school course to many students who live outside the Dresden Special School District, and

Whereas, it appears that such outside students comprise more than fifty per cent of the students in such school, and that they receive the same advantages, considerations and opprotunities as the students living within such Special School District, and

Whereas, it appears that at a prior term of this Court on appropriation in the sum of \$10500.00 was made to such school district for the purpose of erecting an addition to such school building for the housing of the Vocational Department, and

Whereas, it appears that the State Department of Education would approve none of the several plans submitted for building such annex to the present building, and a separate building had to be erected to house such vocational department, which building is now in the process of construction at a cost that will run to approximately \$20,000.00, a sum about \$9,500.00 short of the amount of money available, and

Whereas, it appears that such building is absolutely essential to the school program

in Weakley County, and that the same must be finished in order to be of any benefit to the school, and in order to save the amount already invested in the same;

Therefore, be it resolved, that the Weakley County Quarterly Court borrow a sum of money not exceeding \$10,000.00, payable within the next five years, at a rate of interest not exceeding one and one-half (1 1/2) per cent. Said sum of money to be borrowed on the faith and credit of Weakley County, Tennessee, and the County Judge, the County Court Clerk and the Trustee are hereby authorized to negotiate such loan, sign a note or voucher for the borrowing of such money, and that the County guarantee the full payment of such loan, together with interest, and the costs of collection of such notes or vouchers. All such monies, when borrowed, shall be deposited in the County General Fund, with the Trustee, and such sum of \$10,000.00 is hereby appropriated for the purpose of finishing the aforesaid building, and ordered paid to the Dresden Special School District, upon presentation of itemized bills and statements of the balance of the costs of such building to the County Judge, who shall draw warrants for the same.

This resolution was presented by Esquire Bill House, who made a motion that the same be adopted, and it was seconded by Esquire Clyde Tilley and others. The roll was called, and 45 Magistrates were recorded as voting for such resolution, whereupon it was declared Adopted. (1 present and not voting)
