
A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Martin Public School had a total enrollment of 819 pupils and average daily attendance of 696 pupils for school term 1946-1947; 561 enrolled in the Elementary School with an average daily attendance of 465 and 258 enrolled in High School with an average daily attendance of 231; and,

WHEREAS, The Elementary School Building is wholly inadequate to accommodate the pupils, and said building is obsolete and in poor repair; and,

WHEREAS, The City School Board has under consideration the erection of a modern school building sufficient to accommodate the pupils of said district at a cost of, approximately, \$350,000; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, by the Quarterly Court of Weakley County, Tennessee, That the sum of \$150,000 is hereby appropriated, such fund to be made available to aid in the construction of said school building.
