

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the County Court of Weakley County, Tennessee, met in regular session on January 5, 1959, and,

WHEREAS, it was called to the Court's attention that a bill would be introduced in the legislature of the State of Tennessee, now assembled in Nashville, Tennessee, providing that all county officials be required to make a bond covering their actions as such public county officials, and that the county would be required to pay the premium on the bond or bonds required of its county officials, and,

WHEREAS, this Honorable Court feels that such action should be left to the sound discretion of each individual County Court;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this Court goes on record as unanimously opposing any such general bill or any bill of a similar nature and hereby requests any and all persons representing this County in the legislature to oppose any and all such bills with all of their energy and to vote against any and all such bills that may come before the legislature.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be spread upon the minutes of this Court, and a copy of same be immediately forwarded by the Clerk of this Court to the Honorable Thomas Akin, Direct Representative, the Honorable Damron Collier, Floterial Representative, and the Honorable Dale Glover, State Senator.
