

RESOLUTION

Whereas, it is necessary to keep a more accurate account of the funds of Weakley County, and

Whereas, it is advisable to put Weakley County on a cash, pay-as-you-go, basis, and

Whereas, in order to accomplish the desired results it is necessary to place Weakley County on a budget plan with a Director or Budget, now, therefore,

Be it resolved, that the County Judge is hereby authorized and directed to institute a budget plan in Weakley County, and the County Judge is made the Director of the Budget, and,

Be it further resolved, that all obligations of any nature whatsoever must be cleared through the Budget Director's office in order that proper entries may be made against the various accounts in the Budget, and Weakley County will pay no obligation that is not first cleared through the Budget Director's office, and receives a stamp of that office.

Be it further resolved, that the County Judge be made Purchasing Agent of Weakley County and all purchases made by Weakley County, except those made by the Road Department and School Department, must be made by him, or with his approval.

Be it further resolved that a copy of this Resolution be sent to each official of Weakley County.

This the 2nd day of July, 1951.

Motion was made by Esq. John Hatler, seconded by Esq. Seymour Buckley, that the above Resolution be adopted and approved by the Court. Carried by unanimous voice vote of the Court, and it was so ordered.
