

RESOLUTION

Whereas it appears to the members of the Quarterly Court at its regular session on Jan. 5th, 1953. That under the existing election laws it is next to impossible for all the voters of the 7 Civil District to cast their ballots for the Candidates or their choice during the hours that the poles are open. That it has been observed that long lines of voters have had to stand in line for long periods of time in order to vote. That old people and those physically ill cannot endure this long waiting period to vote. That the election officials have to work until after mid-night in order to count the votes. All of which makes voting a long and worrbersome task.

Now therefore be it resolved by the Quarterly Court in session that we believe it is the duty of every qualified voter to cast his ballot for the candidate of his choice. In order that every person may have the opportunity to vote with a minimum of time and effort we recommend that the 7th Civil District be divided into two voting precincts; that the highway leading from Dresden to Martin and Dresden to Paris be designated as the dividing line between the two precincts. That the voting place for Precinct No. 1 be the Public School Building and the voting place for Precinct No. 2 be the County Court House.
