WHEREAS, Weakley County is justly proud of the Court House and is indebted to all the citizens and officials who gave of their time in the planning and supervision of the building of this structure, and


WHEREAS, Weakley County is especially indebted to the Court House Commission for the fine, unselfish manner in which they served Weakley County, now therefore
