NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the 1954-55 budget be revised to include both the income and expenditures of the following: School bonds, Special District Funds for Dresden, Chestnut Glade and Greenfield, Capital Outlay Unencumbered Cash Balance from 1953-54 Funds, School Extension, and Bus Replacement.
