

Be it remembered that the Weakley County Court of Weakley County, Tennessee, met on this the 4th day of July, 1955, with the Honorable George C. Thomas, County Judge, presiding.

Be it resolved under date of April 13th, 1953, the Weakley County Municipal Electric System, a municipality, owned by Weakley County, Tennessee, did execute a deed to the City of Martin, a municipal corporation, on said date to the following described property, to-wit:

Located in the City of Martin, 2nd Civil District of Weakley County, Tennessee, and bounded and described as follows; Lots Number 19 and 20 of Railroad First Addition to the City of Martin, Tennessee, as per plat recorded in Plat Book No. 1 page 26 in the office of the register of Weakley County, Tennessee.

On the face of the deed it is paramount that this property belonged to the Weakley County Municipal Electric System as they obtained same from the Chicago, St. Louis and New Orleans Railroad Company by deed of October 31st, 1949, which deed is of record in the Register's Office of Weakley County, Tennessee, in Deed Book 98, page 573-4, and that the transaction was entered into on said date and the monies paid to the Weakley County Municipal Electric System by exchange of property. It is therefore resolved that in order to clear the title beyond any reasonable doubt that the said County Court adopts this resolution and most respectfully requests the County Attorney to prepare a proper deed from the County of Weakley County, Tennessee, conveying the above described property to the City of Martin, Tennessee, and have same executed by the County Judge and on behalf of Weakley County, Tennessee.
