
The following resolution read by Judge Thomas:

Whereas, it is necessary to cross under approximately 86 County roads in the Construction of the American-Louisiana natural gas pipe line through a portion of Weakley County which line is proposed to enter Weakley County west of Stafford's Store and run thence in a Northeasterly direction leaving Weakley County North of Ore Springs, and

Whereas, the said American Louisiana Pipeline Company has agreed in writing to leave the said County roads in as good a condition as they found them, and

Whereas, Weakley County is interested in the construction of said pipeline because of the added tax revenue and the close proximity of natural gas, and otherwise, now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that Weakley County hereby grants its permission to the crossing of its County roads to the American Louisiana Pipeline Company under the terms as stated, and the Quarterly County Court hereby authorizes the County Judge to sign a permit granting permission for such crossing.
