
The Following Resolution read by Judge Thomas,

WHEREAS, ~~that~~ appears to be at least a \$25,000.00 surplus in the Debt Service Account, and

WHEREAS, WEAKLEY County needs approximately \$25,000.00 to pay its share of the cost of the right of way for the relocation of Highway Number 22, and

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Quarterly Court pledged the Tax revenue from the American Louisiana Pipeline Company until the cost of said right of way is repaid, now therefore

Be it resolved that the Weakley County Quarterly Court authorized the Trustee of Weakley County to transfer to the General Fund sufficient funds to pay Weakley Counties share of the cost of the right of way for the relocation of Highway #22.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE REVENUE COLLECTED FROM THE TAX ON THE PROPERTY of the American Louisiana Pipeline Co., be allotted to the Debt Service Account until the amount transferred as a result of this resolution is replaced.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that should the Debt Service Account be depleted as a result of this resolution the County Judge and the Finance Committee are hereby authorized to borrow enough money locally to put said Debt Service Account on a sound basis.
