
 * In regard to the matter of closing of the road known as the district line road between the 6th and 24th districts of Weakley County, Tennessee, Mr. M. M. Roberts, made a motion that the former action taken by the County Court in October Term of Quarterly Court, Minute Book 38, Page 182, be resended. Esq. Horace McWhorter seconded the motion; upon being put to a vote, same carried by unanimous voice of the Court.

 Judge Pentecost asked the court to grant David Pugh the County part of privilege license, to sell tobacco, free. Esq. Horace McWhorter made a motion that this be granted, seconded by Esq. Robert Kennedy, carried by unanimous voice vote of the court.

 Laws Rushing made a report to the court on the work of the Rabies Committee, stating that they were trying to locate a site for the dog pound. They were investigating the possibility of locating same on the County Farm property. Mr. George Hearn of the County Farm Committee stated that there might be two problems involved. First, the water supply might not be sufficient; second, the dogs might disturb the people at the rest home.

Esq. C. R. Reams asked to be heard and stated that some of the people are not in favor of the Rabies Program and questioned whether or not the court has the authority to vote this expense on the people of the county. Therefore, he made a motion that there be a roll call vote on the action taken in October Term Court, 1965, Thereupon, Esq. D. Z. Grooms made a motion that this motion be tabled, seconded by Winton Soars- brough. Vote was taken by standing-- 17 voted against and 18 voted for the program.

Esq. D. Z. Grooms made a motion that the Rabies Committee work with the County Farm Committee, seconded by Esq. M. M. Roberts, carried by unanimous voice vote of the court.
