Motion was made by Esq. R. H. Pearson and seconded by Esquire Jack Jolley that the above be approved, Carried by unanimous voice of the Court.

Judge Pentecost asked the Court to have Charles Castellaw, Secretary to Weakley County Municipal Electric System, submit quarterly a financial statement of the monthly receipts and expenditures as approved at each monthly meeting.

Esq. J. D. Taylor made motion that this be granted, seconded by Esq. Horace McWherter Upon being put to a vote, same carried by unanimous voice vote of the Court.

Esq. Paul Rushing asked the Court to approve the following Resolution:

RESOLUTION

TO THE HONORABLE COUNTY JUDGE, CAYCE PENTECOST, AND MEMBERS OF THE WEAKLEY COUNTY QUARTERLY COURT

WHEREAS, The Middle Fork of the Obion River Watershed Project has been voted on by the landowners, and

WHEREAS, a work plan has been prepared by the proper authorities and,

WHEREAS, the landowners in said Watershed District now know the overall cost of the project, and

WHEREAS, the landowners have been advised that they would have an opportunity to again vote to determine whether or not they wanted the project but now learn that there will not be another vote.
