

SUBORDINATION AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the County of Weakley, State of Tennessee, a political subdivision of the State of Tennessee, hereinafter referred to as the Grantor, and the United States of America, hereinafter referred to as the Government, have entered into a certain contract, No. DA-40-041-CIVENG-65-57 dated _____, for the construction by the Government of one bridge crossing Middle Fork Obion River, a part of the West Tennessee Tributaries Project, Weakley County, Tennessee, and acceptance by Grantor of ownership and responsibility for maintenance of said facilities, and.

WHEREAS, the Grantor agreed in said contract to subordinate to the Government, or its local cooperating agency, the Tennessee Department of Highways for the Construction, operation and maintenance of the Project, its right, title and interest in and to the bridge and those portions of the existing road rights of way retained for use of road facilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Grantor by virtue of the authority vested by the Laws of Tennessee and by order duly adopted and entered by Weakley County, Tennessee, in consideration of the mutual promises made and benefits and detriments incurred in the aforementioned contract and in pursuance of said contract and in discharge of the obligations assumed thereunder, does hereby subordinate all right, title and interest in and to the bridge and road rights of way hereinafter described, and the facilities located thereon, unto the right of the Government and the Tennessee Department of Highways, and their assigns to construct, operate and maintain the aforementioned Project, as follows:

The subordination herein granted covers those parts of road rights of way and the facilities situated thereon, retained for use as road facilities, within the limits of the work altered under Contract No. DA-40-041-CIVENG-65-57 dated _____ as shown on Corps of Engineers drawing, Serial 17814, File 162/379, attached to said contract as Exhibit B, and said drawing attached hereto and made a part hereof; said parts of the road rights of way, and facilities covered by this agreement being situated in Weakley County, Tennessee.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the grantees and their assigns for the purpose aforesaid forever, together with all the singular the tenements, appurtenances, and hereditaments thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining.
