RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Laws of the State of Tennessee now permit the hunting of deer in Weakley County, Tennessee, with high powered rifles as well as by other means, and WHEREAS, it is considered by the residents of this County to be very dangerous to permit the hunting of deer with high powered rifles which will shoot for long distances because of the fact that Weakley County, Tennessee, is so thickly populated, and

WHEREAS, it appears that it would be to the manifest best interest of the Citizens of Weakley County, if regulations were promulgated by Tennessee Fish and Game Commission outlawing the hunting of deer in Weakley County, Tennessee, with high powered rifles.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE WEAKLEY COUNTY QUARTERLY COURT in Regular Session assembled on this the 12th day of October, 1970, that said Quarterly County Court does by the adoption of this Resolution condemn the hunting of deer in Weakley County, Tennessee, with high powered rifles.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY SAID QUARTERLY COURT that it does favor the Tennessee Fish and Game Commission promulgating a regulation prohibiting the hunting of deer in Weakley County, Tennessee with high powered rifles.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT a copy of this Resolution be certified by the Clerk of this Court and forwarded to Tennessee Fish and Game Commission for its consideration and action and copies be sent to the elected members of the General Assembly of the State of Tennessee.

Motion was made by Esq. W. M. Stow and seconded by Esq. Wesley Perkins that the foregoing resolution be approved by the Court. Upon being put to a voice vote, same carried unanimously.
