

REGULAR MEETING OF THE WEAKLEY COUNTY LEGISLATIVE BODY
OCTOBER 20, 1986

County Commissioners met in regular session on October 20, 1986. Newly elected County Executive Kerry S. Killebrew called the meeting to order with Comm. V. J. Shanklin giving invocation. Deputy Sheriff Jeff Seaton opened court and County Clerk called roll. Nineteen commissioners present with one absent, that being Comm. Joe White.

ELECTION OF CHAIRMAN OF COUNTY COMMISSION: Comm. James H. Bell made a motion to elect Co. Executive Kerry S. Killibrew as chairman by acclamation. Comm. V. J. Shanklin seconded the motion. By voice vote, motion passed.

ELECTION OF CHAIRMAN PRO TEM: Motion made by Comm. Lewis Garner to dispense with the motion to and to elect COMM. JOHNNY VINCENT as Chairman Pro Tem. Motion seconded by Comm. James H. Bell. By voice vote, motion carried.

Motion to accept the minutes of the regular meeting from July 21, 1986, as corrected, was made by Comm. Charles Culver and seconded by Comm. Earl Wright. After a voice vote, motion carried.

TRUSTEE: Motion to accept the trustees report was made by Comm. Ronnie Batres and seconded by Comm. James Harold Bell. After a voice vote, motion carried.

GENERAL FUND: Motion to accept the General Fund report was made by Comm. Earl Wright and seconded by Comm. Lewis Garner. After a voice vote, motion carried.

HIGHWAY DEPT. Motion to accept the highway dept. report was made by Comm. Charles Culver and seconded by Comm. James H. Bell. After a voice vote, motion carried.

SCHOOL DEPT: Motion to accept the school dept. report was made by Comm. Sam Sinclair and seconded by Comm. V. J. Shanklin. After a voice vote, motion carried.

NURSING HOME REPORT: Kenneth Wainscott, Administrator, was present to answer any question concerning his report. All commissioners approved his report.

AGRICULTURAL EXTENSION SERVICE REPORT: All Commissioners approved the report turned in.

WEAKLEY COUNTY MUNICIPAL ELECTRIC SYSTEM REPORT: All Commissioners approved the report turned in.

CHAMBER OF COMMERCE REPORT: Linda Shannon gave a very informative report concerning the jobs that are available and that are planning to locate in Weakley County.

Co. Executive Kerry Killebrew informed the court and commissioners that as of October 1, 1986, sales tax has been taken from food stamp purchases. It will cost the county and cities of the county approximately \$30,000.00 in sales tax revenue for a period of one year.
