

RESOLUTION 1986-17  
RESOLUTION TO AMEND AMBULANCE SERVICE CONTRACT  
RELATIVE TO COMPENSATION

WHEREAS, on the 18th day of July, 1983, Weakley County, Tennessee, entered into an Ambulance Service Contract with Weakley County Ambulance Service, Inc., a Tennessee Non-profit Corporation; and

WHEREAS, said contract provides for amendments thereto from time to time; and

WHEREAS, Weakley County Ambulance Service, Inc., has presented a request to the Weakley County Board of Commissioners' Ambulance Committee, for an increase in certain fees charged to persons utilizing the services provided; and

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Ambulance Committee voted unanimously at an official meeting on April 3, 1986, to recommend approval of the proposed patient fee increases to the full Board of Weakley County Commissioners.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Weakley County, Tennessee, meeting in regular session, this the 21st day of April, 1986, that:

1. Paragraph 4 of the original contract, as amended, called compensation, shall be amended as follows:
  - A. Paragraph 4g, as amended, shall be further amended to read: "Waiting time charge will be \$15.00 per half hour and \$.50 per minute for longer waits with a minimum charge of \$15.00."
  - B. Paragraph 4, as amended is further amended to allow the following as Paragraph 4L: The Company will have an Emergency Traffic Surcharge from point of pickup to receiving medical facility of \$10.00.
  - C. Paragraph 4A, as amended, shall be further amended to change the rate for pickups in Weakley County, Tennessee, from \$50.00 to \$60.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the aforementioned amendments to the Ambulance Service Contract shall be effective on April 22, 1986 at 12:01 a.m.
