

RESOLUTION NO. 1989-15

AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF AN APPLICATION TO THE TENNESSEE
DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FOR COMMUNITY
DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM FUNDS

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Legislative Body of Weakley County, having committed itself to the improvement of the communities which it represents, has determined that a new fire truck for the Palmersville Volunteer Fire Department is a most pressing need of the community; and

WHEREAS, having determined proper eligibility for application according to CDBG Program guidelines, said governing body wishes to make application for \$66,000 in grant funds to implement the afore-mentioned project and will commit \$ 9,000 in County funds as the remaining share of the total project cost;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body of Weakley County meeting in session on this the 17th day of April, 1989, that the County Executive is hereby authorized to make and sign application for CDBG funds, to commit said County funds, to authorize any required environmental documentation, and to enter into any and all necessary agreements and assurances to consummate the application and implement the project.
