

WEAKLEY COUNTY LEGISLATIVE BODY
REGULAR MEETING-JANUARY 22, 1991

In the regular meeting of the county commission, C. Exec. Kerry Killebrew called the meeting to order with Comm. Lewis Garner giving invocation. Sheriff Mike Wilson opened court and County Clerk Faye Butts called roll with 19 present. Comm. David McAlpin is absent as he is with the National Guard Unit 1174th Division in Saudi Arabia. A special prayer was said for him as well as all the other troops in the desert. Approval of the minutes of October 15, 1990 meeting was made by Comm. James H. Bell and seconded by Comm. Jimmy Brasfield. After a voice vote, motion carried.

TRUSTEE REPORT: Motion to accept the trustees report was made by Comm. Vernon Dunn and seconded by Comm. George Broussard. After a voice vote, motion carried.

GENERAL FUND REPORT: Motion to accept this report was made by Comm. James H. Bell and seconded by Comm. Lewis Garner. After a voice vote, motion carried.

HIGHWAY DEPT. REPORT: Motion to accept this report was made by Comm. Charles Culver and seconded by Comm. V. J. Shanklin. After a voice vote, motion carried.

SCHOOL DEPT REPORT. Motion to accept this report was made by Comm. Jerry Carpenter and seconded by Comm. V. J. Shanklin. After a voice vote, motion carried.

NURSING HOME REPORT: Motion to accept this report was made by Comm. Earl Wright and seconded by Comm. Wayne McCreight. After a voice vote, motion carried.

AMBULANCE COMMITTEE REPORT: Comm. Earl Wright, chairman, wanted to thank Jeff Washburn and the ambulance service for testing Goodyear tires on the vehicles. Motion to accept this report was made by Comm. James H. Bell and seconded by Comm. Vernon Dunn. After a voice vote, motion carried.

BUDGET COMMITTEE REPORT: No report.

FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT: Comm. Dunn, chairman, reported all is going well. The office will be without an employee for awhile, but that poses no problems. Motion to accept this report was made by Comm. J. T. Walker and seconded by Comm. John Bucy. After a voice vote, motion carried.

HEW REPORT: Comm. Vincnet, chairman, reported that they met this morning and are in the middle of changing solid waste Disposal Regulation between state and federal government. ^{The Co.} Exec. will keep HEW updated and they will do the same for the court. The county is involved in trying to accumulate a grant for Total Communication, where all services will fit into our emergency plan for the county and that will be coming later. Motion to accept this report was made by Comm. John Bucy and seconded by Comm. V. J. Shanklin. After a voice vote, motion carried.

LAW ENFORCEMENT REPORT: Comm. VanCleave, chairman, reported they had budget transfers. The jail has an average of 34 prisoners with a cost of running at \$22.00 per day. Motion to accept the report was made by Comm. Brasfield and seconded by Comm. Earl Wright. After a voice vote, motion carried.

PERSONAL COMMITTEE REPORT: Comm. Jimmy Brasfield, chairman, reported that the heavy rains caused the men of the highway dept. to be called in off of vacation and they were wanting time and a half. Comm. Bates makes a motion that the exception be made and these employees be paid at time and a half and this also be referred to the Personal Committee for an update or clarification of the Personal Handbook. Second the motion was made by Comm. Salmon. After a roll call vote, motion carried.
