WEAKLEY COUNTY LEGISLATIVE BODY

REGULAR MEETING APRIL 19, 1993

Co. Executive Kerry Killebrew, call the meeting to order and Comm. Charles Culver gave invocation. All court stood and said the pledge to the flag. Sheriff Mike Wilson opened court and County Clerk Faye Butts called roll with 18 present and 1 absent, that being Comm. Jerry Carpenter.

Approval of minutes : Motion was made by Comm. Vernon Dunn and seconded by Comm. John Salmon. After a voice vote, motion carried.

TRUSTEE'S REPORT: Motion to accept the trustee's report was made by Comm. David McAlpin and seconded by Comm. Lewis Garner. After a voice vote, motion carried.

GENERAL FUND REPORT: Motion to accept this report was made by Comm. Charels Culver and seconded by Comm. J. T. Walker. After a voice vote, motion carried.

HIGHWAY DEPT. REPORT: Motion to accept this report was made by Comm. David McAlpin and seconded by Comm. Charles Culver. After a voice vote, motion carried.

SCHOOL DEPT REPORT: Motion to accept his report was made by Comm. Vernon Dunn and seconded by Comm. John Bucy. After a voice vote, motion carried.

AMBULANCE COMMITTEE REPORT: Comm. Earl Wright, chairman, reported there was no changes at this time.

BUDGET COMMITTEE REPORT: Comm. Culver, chairman, said resolutions were to come later in meeting.

FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT REPORT: Comm. Dunn, chairman, reported all is good, and they are reworking the personel policy and it will be done in the future. The transition period has gone smoothly and Buddy is doing a good job. Motion to accept this report was made by Comm. Charles Culver and seconded by Comm. James H. Bell. After a voice vote, motion carried.

HEW COMMITTEE REPORT: Comm. Vincent, chairman, reported on the War Memorial Monument. It is under construction now and the the dedication will be May 30, 1993 at 2:00 p.m. Everyone is invited to come. The Solid Waste 3 County Committee has been meeting regularly and taking bids for the Solid Waste Plan. The best 3 bids will be interviewed tonight 4-19-93 at the Obion County Courthouse and everyone is invited to come. Co. Exec. Killebrew reported that he had talked to Randy McGill of 911 and they are in McKenzie and Gleason is wrapped up, so things are getting closer now. After a voice vote, this report was accepted.

LAW ENFORCEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT: Comm. VanCleave reported on the status of the new equipment and it should be ready and in effect by the end of the month. We are fast approaching on the DUI Task Force. We are also looking into starting our own DUI school here in Weakley County. The money would go into General Fund and the county attorney is checking this to see if we have to have a resolution. Motion to accept this report was made by Comm. David McAlpin and seconded by Comm. Earl Wright. After a voice vote, motion carried.

PROPERTY COMMITTEE REPORT: Comm. McCreight, chairman, reported that the Martin Bldg. project is coming in at or below budget at this time.

NURSING HOME REPORT: David McBride,, adm., reported that they have hired 6 new LPN's, since the last meeting. Co. Exec. Killebrew said the commission asked him and Supt. Barber, and Mr. Maddox to check in in with state legislators to maybe re-impliment the LPN program at the vocational school. They me with Rep. Herron, Dept. of Ed., the Governor and are trying to get this going. Motion to accept this report was made by Comm. McCreight and seconded by Comm. John Bucy. After a voice vote, motion carried.

APPOINTMENT OF COMMISSIONER IN DISTRICT 2 TO FILL THE VACANCY OF V. J. SHANKLIN DUE TO HIS RESIGNATION. Comm. Charles Culver nonimates John Oliver to fill the vacancy. Comm. Bates makes a motion the nomination cease and that he be elected by acclamation. After a voice vote, motion carried.

Mr. V. J. Shanklin was given a plaque for his years of service by Co. Exec. Killebrew and the commission.

Comm. Brasher makes a motion to suspend the rules on 18 resolutions that pretain to schools. After a period of discussion, have just one roll call vote. Comm. James H.
