

REGULAR MEETING OF COMMISSIONERS

OCTOBER 15, 1990

The regular meeting of the county commissioners was held on October 15, 1990 with Co. Exec. Kerry Killebrew calling the meeting to order. Invocation was held by Comm. Charles Culver and Sheriff Mike Wilson opened court. County Clerk Faye Butts called roll with 19 present and 1 absent, that being Joe Brasher. Approval of minutes from July 16, 1990 was made by Comm. Vernon Dunn and seconded by Comm. Roger VanCleave. After a voice vote, motion carried.

TRUSTEES REPORT: Motion to accept the report was made by Comm Sam Sinclair and seconded by Comm. Earl Wright. After a voice vote, motion carried.

GENERAL FUND REPORT: Motion to accept this report was made by Comm. James H. Bell and seconded by Comm. Lewis Garner. After a voice vote, motion carried.

HIGHWAY DEPT. REPORT: Motion to accept this report was made by Comm. James H. Bell and seconded by Comm. George Broussard. After a voice vote, motion carried.

SCHOOL DEPT. REPORT: Motion to accept this report was made by Comm. George Broussard and seconded by Comm. David McAlpin. After a voice vote, motion carried.

AMBULANCE COMMITTEE REPORT: Comm. Earl Wright reported to court that all was going well. Motion to accept this report was made by Comm. John Salmon and seconded by Comm. John Bucy. After a voice vote, motion carried.

FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT: Comm. Dunn reported to the court that all was going well and the audit that was just completed was very favorable. There was a discussion as why the county did not use Goodyear tires. It was reported that it will be checked out. Motion to accept this report was made by Comm. Jerry Carpenter and seconded by Comm. George Broussard. After a voice vote, motion carried.

HEW REPORT: Comm. Johnny Vincent, reported to the court that they had met several times about 911. Randy McGill of Municipal Services Company, who submitted the lowest bid would do the mapping and addressing. Comm. Vincent said it will take about 12 months and \$23,500.00 Mr. McGill explained to the court the procedure they would have to do, the renaming of roads and mapping of the county. Comm. Vincent said it was their thinking that the Weakley County Highway Commission would name the roads. Motion to accept this report was made by Comm. Sam Sinclair and seconded by Comm. John Salmon. LAW ENFORCEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT: Comm. After a voice vote, motion carried.

AGRICULTURAL EXTENSION SERVICE REPORT: Jerry McMaster gave the court their report and thanked them for all their help and support. Motion to accept this report was made by Comm. John Bucy and seconded by Comm. David McAlpin. After a voice vote, motion carried.

WCMS REPORT: Gerald Brooks reported that the cable system issue was dead. He reported it was not feasible. Motion to accept this report was made by Comm. Earl Wright and seconded by Comm. Roger VanCleave. After a voice vote, motion carried.
