PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE
May 22, 2007; 4:00 P.M.**

Public Safety Members Present: Commissioners John Salmon, Jack Vincent, Tommy Hunt, Roger Stewart, Kevin McAlpin, and Earl Wright.

The Public Safety Committee met on May 22, 2007 at 4:00 p.m. at the Weakley County Department of Finance in the conference room. Others present Shawn Francisco-Director of Finance, Mike Wilson-Sheriff, and Jamison Peeveyhouse-representing 911. Chairman Jack Vincent called the meeting to order.

OLD BUSINESS:

Commissioner Wright made the motion to approve the May 7, 2007 minutes and with a second by Commissioner Salmon the motion passed unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS:

2007-08 FY Sheriff & Jail Proposed Budgets

Commissioner Stewart made the motion to place the budgets on the floor for discussion and with a second by Commissioner Wright the motion passed unanimously.

Sheriff Wilson presented the budgets to the committee.

Sheriff Department

Line # 106 Deputies includes 19 current and 1 open position.

Line #334 Maintenance Agreements includes maintenance cost for the state terminal system that includes the ability to access from two systems.

Line #355 Travel includes all employees' travel as well as the transportation costs incurred transporting prisoners.

Line #431L/E Supplies/Ammo includes supplies for employees to have ammo training two full days.

Line #718 Motor Vehicles includes purchase of 4 vehicles and equipping the new vehicles with lights, screens, etc.

Jail Budget

#160 Guards- includes 0 new employees & no open positions.

#399 Other Contracted Services includes funds for the generator maintenance contract and to contract with a professional to administer medical treatment to inmates.

Detention Center Building Maintenance - Sheriff Wilson stated that the carpet in the courtroom, administration offices are in bad condition and in need of replacement. All other aspects of the facility seem to be fine.

2007-08 FY Dispatchers Budget

Jamison Peeveyhouse presented the dispatcher budget to the committee. Line #148 dispatcher shows an increase of \$12,000; due to the 911 Board sending an additional \$12,000 for the 2007-08 FY. Currently there are 10 dispatchers employed.

Commissioner Stewart made the motion to table the budgets as presented and with a second by Commissioner Salmon the motion passed unanimously.

Commissioner Stewart made the motion to adjourn and with a second by Commissioner Salmon the meeting adjourned at 4:45 p.m.
